Increase In Hunting & Furtaker Licenses Proposed increases

The Game Commission's proposal to in crease fees for hunting and furtaker licenses would not affect junior hunting licenses, junior combination licenses or senior hunting licenses. Those licenses would remain at \$5, \$8 and \$12, respectively, plus \$1.70 in fees that are split between the issuing agent and license processor. Most other resident and nonresident license fees would increase three times in five years under the proposal. The cost of a resident adult hunting or furtaker license would increase by \$10 in the first year fees are changed, then would increase by \$5 in the third year, and another \$5 in the fifth year of the plan. Fees for bear, antlerless deer, archery, muzzleloader, migratory game bird and special wild turkey (second spring gobbler) licenses also would see increases as part of the proposal. A chart showing the proposed increases is included with this news release. More information about the proposal for an increase also can be found at the Game Commission's website. But as part of its proposal, the Game Commission also seeks to create a new license that could be used to participate in just about all hunting and trapping opportunities in Pennsylvania, and at a significant discount for those who purchase it.
